Subject: Recommend Approving the AGECE (Applied GeoTech) Proposal for Professional Geotechnical Services regarding the Truman Drive Landslide.

We have asked James Nordquist the engineer with AGECE to give us a proposal on any additional work or investigation that should take place now that we have been awarded the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant for the Truman Drive Slide. Mr. Nordquist has worked with the City over the years in regards to mitigating this site, and has been the geotechnical engineer in putting together the application; therefore, he is very familiar with what is going on at this location.

As per the proposal they conclude that “based on the existing conditions and performance of the slope, we recommend that subsurface exploration, laboratory testing and engineering analysis be conducted” (see scope A of the attached proposal in the council packet).

There are funds available within the Grant to do additional testing and engineering. The Fee for the services is an amount up to \$96,000 based on hourly and unit costs. I recommend that if City Council approves the proposal that they do so with a not-to-exceed amount of \$96,000.
