Staff Report:

On October 10<sup>th</sup> Todd Olsen reviewed the changes to the Construction Standards regarding the Storm Drain and Asphalt Standards in the last work meeting. Over the past year the Washington County Flood Control Authority has reviewed each City's Storm Drain Standards and put together new standards that each City in Washington County can adopt.

Washington City has created a standard for asphalt that reduces the amount of rap that can be in the asphalt mix and improves the quality of oil. It also requires an inspector to be on site as the asphalt is mixed and tested. These changes have already been included in the Santa Clara Standards.

Change thickness of sidewalks from 4" to 6".
