

**CITY OF SANTA CLARA
RESOLUTION NO. 2016-17R**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, UTAH AMENDING
POWER IMPACT FEES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Santa Clara City finds that it is necessary from time to time to amend fee schedules to properly compensate the City for services rendered; and

WHEREAS, Electric System impact fees are one time charges assessed for new connections to the electric system. Impact Fees are based upon the cost incurred by the City for improvement projects to address new demands placed on the City's Electric System by anticipated new development; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found that the cost associated with providing power connections for commercial and residential developments has increased significantly over time requiring an amendment to the City's Power Impact Fee Schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted an Electric System Impact Fee Analysis as part of Santa Clara City's Capital Facilities Plan Update. It has been determined that a total demand placed on the existing system by new development during a 5 yr. period is 3.3 megawatts, and 20 yrs.is 13.2 megawatts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Santa Clara City Council that the power connection fees for commercial and residential developments be amended as listed in the attached Exhibit "A" and that the Impact fee will be collected 100 % at Building Permit Issuance.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective the billing cycle beginning on or about January 1, 2017 and upon appropriate adoption, recording, and posting in the manner prescribed by law.
