CLEAN UP DUMPSTERS

Clean up dumpsters will be available September 4—5, 2020. There will be 3 dumpsters at the Little League Parking Lot and 1 at the Town Hall Parking Lot. Please do not leave trash on the ground before dumpsters arrive or after they have been removed. These dumpsters are not for disposal of large items like furniture & appliances, and not for disposal of tires, batteries, paint and any hazardous chemical waste, and not for construction site waste—construction sites will have their own dumpsters. If you have large items such as furniture or old appliances that need disposed of please call Republic Services at 628-2821 for a special bulky item pick up. Removed vegetation like tree limbs or shrubs can be taken to the St. George Reuse Center for mulching—they are located at 575 E. Brigham Road, phone # :435-627-4028.

FREE WATER CHECKS



Water Checks is a free annual program from May 15 to September 30 that provides participants a recommended efficient watering schedule that results in an average 30-percent water savings. An irrigation specialist will come to your home to run a series of tests on your sprinkler system, which will take approximately

one hour. Since the water district launched this program in 2005, more than 2,500 water checks have been performed resulting in an estimated water savings in excess of 20 billion gallons. Call 435.673.3617 to schedule an appointment.



STORM WATER

With the recent storm that Washington County received on August 23, 2020, some areas accumulated over two inches of rain in a very short amount of time. Santa Clara City did not receive the full effect as other cities within the area. Santa Clara City's storm drain system performed extremely well during this event. However, we did experience some water issues because of storm grates being clogged by pine needles, grass clippings, and leaves. A friendly reminder to Santa Clara City residents of your responsibility to collect and discard those above items from your property in your waste containers. Remember, only rain in the drain!

No action is needed. Your service will stay as-is unless you take action to change it.




